Having no business to come before the Executive Committee, Mr. Williams opened the February 24, 2010 Regular Board Meeting.

Mr. Williams welcomed Mr. Vavrek and invited him to address the Board.

## **I. Approval of Meeting Minutes**

Mr. Rocco noted the inclusion of Mr. Chory's name on the January 26, 2010 meeting minutes appearing twice on the list of members attending from the Town of Trumbull and his name was omitted although he was in attendance. The correction was noted.

By motion made by Mr. Vecsey, seconded by Mr. Rocco the minutes of the January 26, 2010 meeting were approved with the inclusion of Mr. Rocco in attendance from the Town of Trumbull.

## **II. Communications and Announcements**

### **1. Financial Report**

Mr. Nielsen presented the Financial Report for the period July 1, 2009 through January 31, 2010.

### **2. Regional Council of Elected Officials**

Mr. Nielsen updated the members on the status of the Agency reorganizing to become a Regional Council of Elected Officials.

Mr. Ward referred to an article in the February 24, 2010 edition of the New Haven Register referring to a proposal by Mayor John DeStefano of New Haven allowing regions to increase sales tax. Mr. Nielsen offered comments.

### **3. Technology Action Program**

Mr. Nielsen reported that the Agency has been actively working on establishing a network and backup server to share and store data. Mr. Bidolli offered additional information on the status and cost of the components necessary to achieve data security.

4. Request for Proposals – Agency Personnel Policy Update

Mr. Nielsen informed members that the RPF for Human Resources Consultant has been finalized and will be posted on the State of Connecticut DAS (Department of Administrative Services) website.

A discussion followed. Members voiced concerns regarding the potential cost of the consulting fee. Mrs. Taylor suggested using staff input as a method to keep costs down.
